

APPLYING FOR A WELL INSPECTION AND WATER SAMPLE

In order to apply for a **WELL INSPECTION**, the following information must be available at the time the application is made in the Central Permits Office. This information is required for each well that requires a well inspection. The cost for a well inspection is \$50.00 for each property.

1. Is the well inspection being performed for a property transfer?
2. What is the closing date?
3. What type of well(s) is to be inspected—drilled or bored?
4. How old is the well to be inspected?
5. Is the casing visible?
6. Is a water sample needed?
7. Where is the well located on the property?

In order to apply for a **WATER SAMPLE**, the following information must be available at the time the application is made in the Central Permits Office. If a well inspection is requested at the same time, the duplicate information from the well inspection marked with an asterisk (*) will be copied from one application to another application. The cost for a water sample is \$30.00 for each sample collected.

1. Is the water sample being performed for a property transfer?*
2. What is the closing date?*
3. How many wells are located on the property?
4. What type of well(s) is on the property—drilled or bored?
5. Is there an outside faucet available?
6. Where is the faucet located?
7. Where is the well located on the property?*
8. How old is the well from which the sample is to be collected?*
9. What type of water sample do you want collected?
 - a. Coliform Bacteria
 - b. Fluoride
 - c. Iron Bacteria
 - d. Inorganic Chemical
 - e. Lead
 - f. Nitrate/Nitrite
 - g. Pesticide
 - h. Petroleum
 - i. Sulfate-Reducing/Sulfur Bacteria
 - j. Other (must check with Environmental Health).
