RE: RFB for Emergency Medical Ambulance Remounts

Pursuant to G.S. 143-131, informal bidding requirements, a Request for Bids was issued for the remounting of three (3) currently owned ambulance boxes onto three (3) new Ford F350 Ambulance Cabs and Chassis for the Randolph County Emergency Services Department. The public was notified of the issuance of this Request for Bids by a legal notice which ran in the Courier-Tribune on Sunday, June 29, 2008 and through a posting of the Request for Bids on the County website. This RFB was also e-mailed to three (3) potential vendors on Friday, June 27, 2008.

On Thursday, July 10, 2008 at 3:00 P.M. sealed bids were received, opened and read. Bids for the remounting of three (3) ambulance boxes onto new Ford F350 Ambulance Cabs and Chassis were received from the following Vendors:

All of the bids received were found to be in compliance with the specifications outlined in the RFB with only minor exceptions. The bids were reviewed by the Emergency Services Department and the Purchasing Office and found to be acceptable. The Emergency Services Departments has identified funds within their budget that will allow them to proceed, if approved, with the remounting of three ambulance boxes that are currently in use onto three (3) new 2008 Ford F350 Ambulance Cabs and Chassis.

Based on the bid received from **Southeastern Specialty Vehicles, located in West Jefferson, North Carolina**, being found to be responsive in meeting the specifications outlined in the RFB, their timetable for delivery of the remounted vehicles, Randolph County's past working experience with Southeastern Specialty, and the price quoted, it is the recommendation of the Emergency Services Department and the Purchasing Office that the Board of Commissioners approve and award the bid for three (3) EMS Ambulance Remounts at a total price of **\$77,997.00** to **Southeastern Specialty Vehicles**.
